As a U.S. Army veteran, I understand firsthand the weight of invisible battles. After navigating my own journey with PTSD following military service, I came to understand how life-changing it is to have support from someone who truly understands. That experience is what led me to create Koko Bella Diamonds offering peer support services to women.

Koko Bella Diamonds was built with a vision to walk alongside women across Ohio who are navigating mental health challenges such as depression, anxiety, PTSD, trauma, schizophrenia, postpartum changes, grief, emotional distress and SUD. Many women do not require inpatient care, but they do need consistent support, meaningful connection, and someone who will meet them where they are.

Our services are led by women with lived experience who provide non-clinical, person-centered support rooted in hope, empowerment, and understanding. We are not here to replace clinical care, but to complement it by offering something just as essential, real human connection from someone who has walked a similar path. For the women we serve, we are a safe space to be heard, supported, and encouraged.

For our community partners, we are a trusted extension of care, helping bridge the gap between clinical services and everyday life.

We believe that when women are supported in a way that feels genuine and consistent, they are better able to move forward, rebuild, and reconnect with their sense of purpose. Our vision is to create a stronger, more connected community across Ohio where no woman feels like she has to navigate her journey alone, and where organizations can confidently refer knowing their clients will be supported with compassion and respect.

Whether you are seeking support or looking to partner with us, we welcome you. Together, we can create spaces where women feel seen, supported, and never alone.
